Level 1 assistance will provide \$500 of the \$995 registration cost (50%); parent and/or student are responsible for the remaining **\$495** cost. Award is only available for the class beginning June 9, 2008.

#### Level 1 Qualification Criteria:

A student must meet all of the following criteria to be eligible to apply for a Level 1 Registration Assistance Award:

1. Member of a Hillsborough County high school or career center CTSO chapter during the 2007-2008 school year (FFA, FBLA, CECF, DECA, FCCLA, HOSA, FPSA, TSA, SkillsUSA)
2. Complete the two part application including approval signatures from your school principal, CTSO chapter advisor,\* and parent
3. Be selected by a Application Review Panel of business, education, parents, and Dale Carnegie representatives

### Level 2 -- Registration Assistance Award Information:

Level 2 assistance will provide \$900 of the \$995 registration cost; parent and/or student are responsible for the remaining **\$95** of the cost. Award is only available for the class beginning June 9, 2008.

#### Level 2 Qualification Criteria:

A student must meet all of the following criteria to be eligible to apply for a Level 2 Registration Assistance Award:

1. Free/Reduced Lunch Recipient
2. Member of a Hillsborough County high school or career center CTSO chapter during the 2007-2008 school year (FFA, FBLA, CECF, DECA, FCCLA, HOSA, FPSA, TSA, SkillsUSA)
3. Complete the two part application including all approval signatures from your principal, CTSO chapter advisor,\* and parent
4. Be selected by the Application Review Panel of business, education, parent, and Dale Carnegie representatives

### \*Important Note to Chapter Advisors and Principals:

CTSO Chapter and/or Student School Site will be reimbursed using Assistance Program funds for your award winning participating students.
